## **Description and Qualifications**

It is not required that the Young Business Leader of the Year award be given each year.

- 1. The nominee must be under 45 years of age
- 2. A nominee may only receive this award one time
- 3. The nominee must have a relationship with the Ruston-Lincoln Chamber of Commerce through membership either as a business owner, an employee of a Chamber member, a member of an organization that is a Chamber member, or has an individual membership
